The BAS major is a selective program that requires an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree for admission. **If you have not earned an AAS degree (or do not anticipate finishing an AAS degree before Mason enrollment), DO NOT SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR THIS MAJOR. Please go back and select another major for your application.**

If you have not earned your AAS degree, but anticipate it will be completed prior to your enrollment at Mason, please read the following statements carefully.

By continuing my application to the BAS program, I understand that...

- My AAS degree must be completed before the first day of the semester at Mason. I will not be permitted to co-enroll at both Mason and my community college in order to finish my AAS degree.
- I need to submit my AAS transcript as soon as possible, and by the end of my first semester at Mason. A registration hold will be placed on my Mason account if my AAS transcript is not received by the last day to drop classes in my first semester.
- My BAS credits may not be awarded until my AAS transcript is received.
- If Mason does not receive my AAS transcript by the end of my first semester, I will be removed from the BAS major.
 - If my major is changed, the classes I have taken up until that time may not apply to my new major.
 - If my major is changed, I will not be permitted to re-enroll in the BAS major at a later time.
 - If my major is changed, I will be dropped from any courses that I am not eligible for under my new major.
 - I accept responsibility for any financial/academic repercussions of the major change and any schedule adjustments.
